DESCRIPTION

Setprior sets the priority of the process to *priority* (0 - 0277). This is the base priority of the process set in the PCB word *p_prior* and the process DCT table entry, and is the priority at which the process normally runs. An increasing value indicates a higher priority. A value of 1 is returned from C.
